Challenge 113

On June 20th (World Refugee Day) some of our supporters and staff completed fundraising activities to raise money for our *Life in the Desert* project. Over the next 12 months we want to train 113 teachers and NGO workers to take our *Life in the Desert* project into refugee camps and more disadvantaged communities. They will then help traumatised children across the region to find healing and restoration. We had people dancing for 113 minutes, cycling for 113km, running 10K, doing various exercises linked to 113 repetitions, and even praying for 113 minutes!

Together we raised over £6,100 - thank you to all involved

An update on our Blossoms Project:

Adjusting to Goronavirus

Due to the outbreak of Coronavirus all face-to-face events have been cancelled, which has meant that our *Blossoms* project has had to adapt. Instead of doing physical events, our teams now run online gatherings for all the Sudanese women going through the programme. Along with online gatherings, we have also recorded 12 videos with psychologists to help with specific trauma needs.

Last Christmas last year we raised over £8,400 to help Sudanese women find restoration and healing from trauma and racism, that they still experience in North Africa on a daily basis. Unfortunately, we couldn't help the 80 women we had planned to, due to not reaching our fundraising goal. However, thanks to your generosity we will be able to help 40 women this year.

The women taking part in these online meetings have felt secure enough to share their fears and experiences, and they're finding the healing and restoration they deeply need. But please continue to pray with us that they would continue to thrive, despite the fact that they will undoubtedly face more racial abuse in their lives.

Globally, 69% of children watch more than 120 minutes per day of online videos. In North Africa, children watch more than 20 videos each day, and they're predicting that both of these statistics will skyrocket throughout Coronavirus lockdown and beyond.

Most of the content being produced in the region for children is poor quality and not pointing them to Jesus. Therefore, we want to take this opportunity to create an online platform and create video content to reach children who are living in our new reality. Initially the Kingdom Platform will focus on reaching children in North Africa, but it will also be accessible to children across the region in a dialect of Arabic that is widely understood.

We want to make the most of children accessing content online, so that these children grow up with Biblical truths in their daily life. We believe that this will help to draw them closer to Jesus. Please join us in praying for this exciting new project and that the thousands of children who access this new platform will be impacted and have their lives transformed.
